



## List of Ashton Reservists listing 5 September 1914

A copy of the 2<sup>nd</sup> list of Ashton Reservists printed in the Cheshire Herald on September 5<sup>th</sup> 1914, exactly a month after war had been declared. There are approximately 550 names and some enlistment numbers but what is really interesting is there is also their home addresses. I noticed that there was a fair smattering of obviously Irish surnames, so they must have integrated well after the Irish riots in Ashton 50 years previously. But what was very obvious is just how many reservists joined up from the same street, 6 from Bengal Street, 8 from Old Street, 2 brothers from Currier Lane, 7 from Park Street, 9 from Hope Street Hurst, 6 from Jermyn Street, 6 from Boodle Street and a massive 15 from Cotton Street (where our Ashton Archives are today.) Also noticeable is how many Police Constables joined up, was anyone left to enforce law and order in Ashton during WW1? Policemen must have all been tall in those days as they were mostly put into the Guard regiments. Then there was the sheer number of different regiments Ashton lads joined. Apart from the obvious Manchester regiment based in Ladysmith Barracks they joined at least 43 other regiments dotted around Britain. I wonder how Ashton lads felt wearing the kilt of the Scottish regiments or sailing the 7 seas after being put in the navy from such a land locked town. Several were sent on their own to join the likes of the South Staffordshire Regiment or the 17<sup>th</sup> Lancers. One wonders how they coped without any immediate friend from Ashton initially. There is also a huge list at the end of names and addresses but labelled *Unspecified*. I suppose it was that their names are mentioned in the local paper but not much use for family historians to try to identify just which regiment is depicted in the photo they have in the family album.

#### ASHTON RESERVISTS

##### Men who have joined the colours

Ashton is vying with other large industrial towns in sending its best sons to the front to conquer the common foe. Below we give a list of the men who have been called up to rejoin their regiments as well as several who have thrown in their lot with Kitchener's army. The list contains practically all the names of all the Ashton reservists who are at present fighting in France. Of those mentioned not a few are already back in this country wounded, while others may be included in the 4600 listed missing. The Ashton contingency is certainly a very creditable one and it is certain that the Ashton lads will give a good account of themselves. The borough is not behind other towns and cities as far recruiting is concerned for the new army and is worthily maintaining its reputation. **The striking feature of the list is the variety of regiments in which the old town is represented.**
